Beverley Married Robert and they lived in Ararat had 2-3 children – never heard much about them.

<u>Edna</u> (young Edna) married Robert and lived in Ballarat – had a number of children but never heard much about them either

<u>George</u> (Georgie) was quite a bit younger than the others – knew he married but nothing more

Aunty Helen married #2 Thomas **Hunter** many years later and lived in Ballarat. Both deceased.
