And to prevent any improper use being made of this Discharge by its falling into other hands the following is a Description of the said William Jones he is about five feet six inches in height fair hair, hazel eyes, fair complexion and by trade a C??????

I **William Jones** do acknowledge that I have received all my clothing, pay and arrears of pay, and all just demands whatsoever from the time of my enlisting in the Regiment mentioned on the other side to this day of my Discharge.

I do hereby certify that the cause which has recorded it to discharge the within mentioned **William**Jones as stated on the opposite side has not arisen from Vice or Misconduct and that his is not to my knowledge incapacitated by the Sentence of a General Court Martial from receiving his pension.
